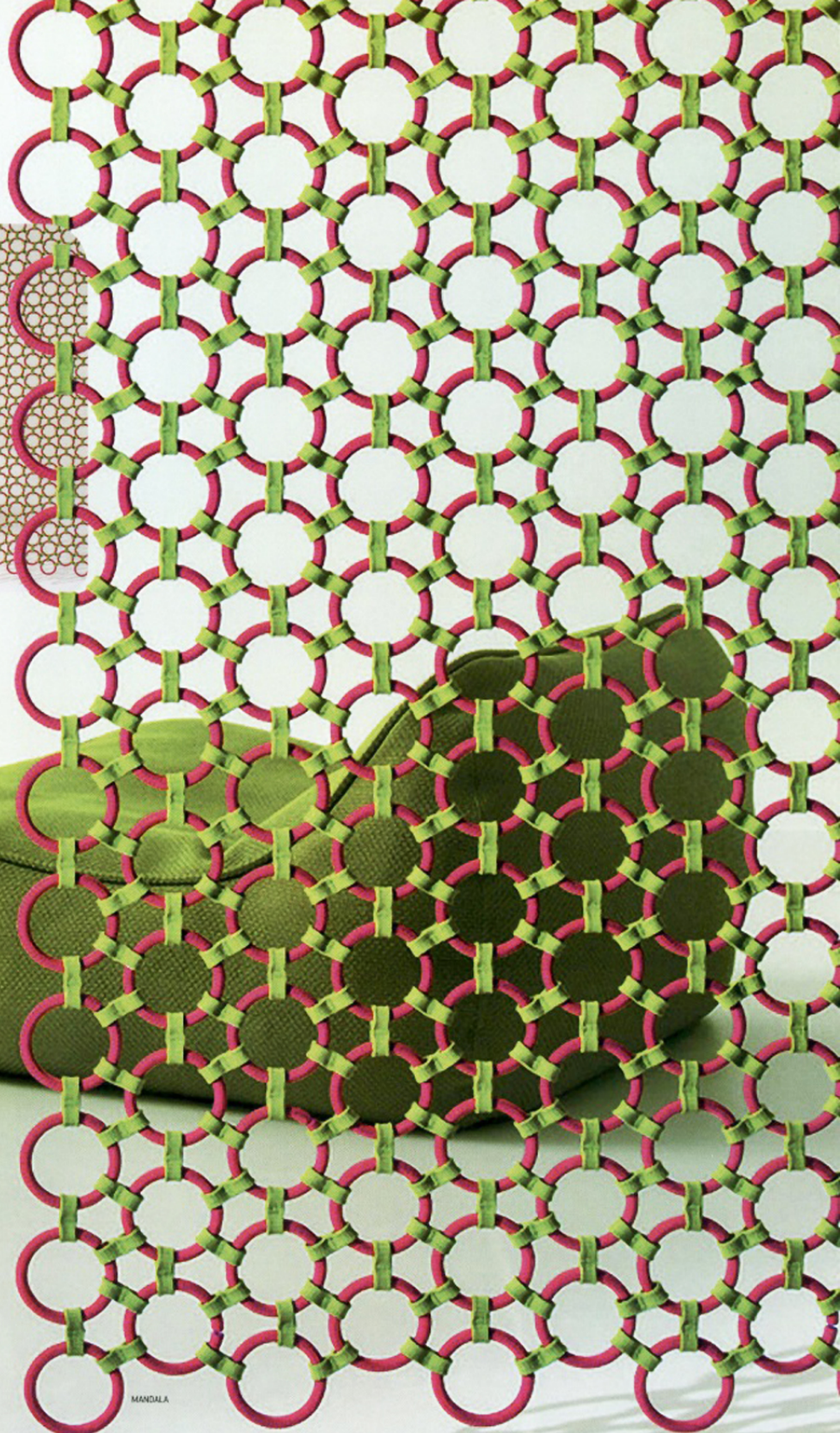

recap When you need a space-making treatment that's there, but almost not there, consider Mandala. Named after the circular shape that figures prominently in Hindu religious symbolism, the customizable textile consists of aluminum rings covered in Rope, the designer's signature braided polyolefin, adjoined by flat cords of the same material but in contrasting color. "Mandala defines an area, dividing without isolating," the designer says. Fixed to the ceiling but freeflowing at the base, the suspended rings allow light and air to pass through effortlessly.
