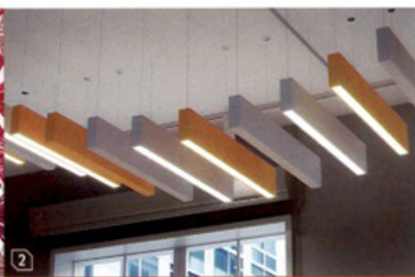

Orbs are strung onto reflective thread that appears to glimmer or vanish depending on the light, resulting in a whimsical wall hanging or curtain partition. 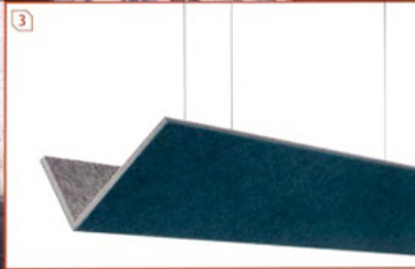
